

The subject matter appears almost random. The flow of the text is rambling and the reader is left searching for a consistent theme. There are a few bright spots in which the reader has a "that's interesting" moment, but these are all too few and mostly the consistent question the reader has in

mind while reading is "where is this heading?". The prose is pleasant, but overall the book is disappointing.

I found this book to be both informative and hilarious. Hitchings provides the framework for a deeper understanding of the many nuanced rituals of everyday life in the UK.
